Why B-double HPVF and not A-doubles?

WIM Resource Pty Ltd (WIM) has assessed the entire route based on what the route is currently approved for.

It is WIM's understanding that currently there is a section of the Wimmera Highway is not approved for A-doubles. Therefore, WIM has opted for high performance B-doubles, which is the approved vehicle type and class, able to transport the HMC payload WIM requires. The remainder of the route can utilise A-doubles. This may change in the future, however the assessment was completed with the currently approved transport options.
